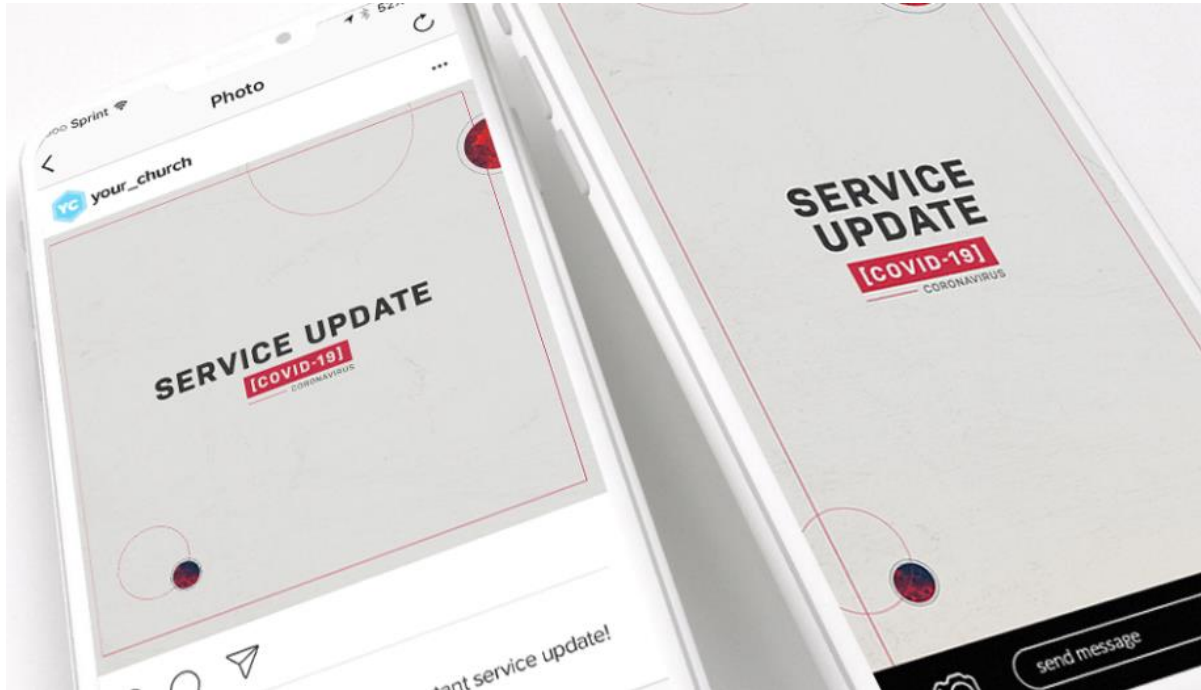


Communication for churches during Coronavirus
